## **Membership Category Explanations**



The classes of Membership of the Society shall be:

### **FULL MEMBERSHIP**

A Full Member shall be the Owner or Nominee of the Owner of any Flock registered with the Society. Voting rights – one vote per Full Membership. Stud membership allows access to the stud register and is principally intended for members wishing to register fullblood Dorpers. Stud members are members of the Society and bound by its constitution. They are entitled to full voting rights at branch and federal levels. On applying for Stud Membership a person shall submit, for approval a preferred prefix

### **COMMERCIAL MEMBERSHIP**

A Commercial Member shall be a person with a special interest in the Dorper breed or White Dorper Breed or a commercial producer. Commercial members are not stud members, but are members of the Society and are bound by its memorandum and articles of Society. They cannot vote at general meetings of the company or nominate for the position of director but can vote at Regional meetings.

### **JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP**

A Junior Member shall be a person of eighteen (18) years or less that is the owner of a registered Flock with the Society. A Junior Membership will allow the ownership of up to twenty (20) registered sheep. The Junior Membership fee to be the same as the Commercial Membership fee and shall have the same voting rights as a Commercial Membership.

### **STUD PREFIX AND FLOCK NUMBER**

When applying for Full or Junior membership, every person accepted as a stud member of the Society intending to register sheep shall record a stud prefix (up to 20 letters) which shall be used as a prefix to and as part of the name of every sheep of which they are the breeder and which is submitted for registration in the register. The use of the word Dorper or White Dorper is not permitted in a prefix.

Each stud member will be issued with a unique flock number by the registrar.

A unique flock number will include both a Dorper and White Dorper flock with the same Prefix.

### **REGISTRARS DISCRETION TO REGISTER NAME**

The registrar may decline to register or record any stud or flock name, stud prefix which, in the opinion of the registrar, resembles that of any other breeder of livestock whether in Australia or elsewhere or which they perceive as contrary to the interests of the Society.

### **MORE THAN ONE FLOCK**

If a person has more than one flock of sheep, whether running on the same property or elsewhere, that person may record with the Society a separate stud prefix and flock number in respect of each flock and pay the prescribed fee in respect of each flock.
