Lumani White Dorpers is situated on JJs Farm in Western Australia, 25km east of the coastal town of Lancelin, 150km north of Perth. We are a husband and wife team – Jill Wilson and John Reymond. Jill has previously worked as an agricultural scientist and John has operated mechanical businesses, but we have now combined our skills to develop an intensive farming venture.

When we started, the basis of our flock was ewes from Haseley stud in WA and a ram from South African stud Kasteel. We have introduced other lines, particularly Ida Vale and Kaya. We are concentrating on developing a small stud of superior quality animals which are low maintenance but highly productive. All animals are performance recorded and we currently select for superior shedding, fast growing progeny, high fertility and low worm resistance.
